

The Cline House Gallery is committed to providing curated exhibitions by local, regional, and visiting artists. Our goal is to provide a balanced exhibition schedule of invitational, juried, themed, and traveling exhibits.

We welcome all emerging and established artists, working in any media or discipline, to apply.

All exhibiting artists are responsible for the transportation of their art to and from the gallery. The gallery will be responsible for installation of the exhibition by a professional gallery technician, opening reception with refreshments, design and printing of promotional materials and the promotion of the exhibition through social media, the gallery website, city website, and tourism activity guides. The Cline House Gallery does not currently pay exhibition fees to artists. A 30% commission is payable to the gallery on all sales.

All artists applying whether for a solo, joint, or group exhibit must submit a complete package as listed

- An Exhibition Proposal maximum 500 words must include title and description of the focus of the planned exhibit
- 8-10 images of your work. Work must be reflective of the artist's direction and intent of exhibition (each artist must submit images for joint or group proposals)
- A list of the submitted images indicating title, medium, size, date for each image
- Artist's Resume
- Artist's Statement (Max. 500 words)
- Your name, address, phone number and email

The gallery typically hangs 30-40 works in each exhibition depending on size and medium. Proposals must account for a sufficient quantity of artwork to warrant any type of exhibit (solo, joint or group).

Exhibition programming is often scheduled one to two years in advance. Receipt of proposals will be acknowledged by email.
